Theme	Statistics	Explanatory notes
Business, economy and financial markets	Enterprises and business demography	These statistics will be scaled down. The quarterly business demography statistics (branch of industry, company size and legal form, closures, legal form and branch of industry, mergers and takeovers) will be published annually instead of quarterly. The Ministry of Economic Affairs has indicated it wants to retain the underlying microdata for assessment surveys, the State of SMEs and the Netherlands Bureau for Economic Policy Analysis.
Regional information	General regionalisation and regional turnover	The Ministry of Economic Affairs has indicated that it is examining options for scaling down these statistics. It has said it will provide financing for 90% of the statistics.
	Environmental Data Compendium	The Ministry of Infrastructure and the Environment will discontinue funding for the Environmental Data Compendium website. Statistics Netherlands is examining how it will adjust the content of the website as a result of this reduction in funding.
Security and justice	Fire services ¹	Statistics on fires and assistance and statistics on employees will be funded completely; the Ministry of Security and Justice will not provide funding for statistics on expenditure on fire services and for a number of activities of Statistics Netherlands not included in direct production.
