Toelichting op de variabelen

RINPERSOONS en RINPERSOON

Bronbestanden die aan het CBS geleverd worden, bevatten doorgaans als persoons-identificator het BSN. Het Burgerservicenummer (BSN) wordt als zeer identificerend beschouwd en daarom vervangt het CBS dit nummer door een intern persoonsidentificatienummer, het betekenisloze RIN-nummer (RINPERSOON).

Een microdatabestand is voorzien van de door het CBS toegevoegde variabelen soort identificatiecode (RINPERSOONS) en identificatienummer (RINPERSOON), die samen het BSN vervangen. Records met een BSN die zijn teruggevonden in de GBA zijn voorzien van een geldig RIN-nummer. Deze records hebben de waarde 'R' op RINPERSOONS gekregen.
