

Authorising a third-party declarant


This quick guide explains how to authorise a third-party declarant to report information on behalf of your company.

For who?

Statistics Netherlands always sends its correspondence to the party required to provide the statistical information, the PSI. To outsource the declaration of your information to a so-called third-party declarant, you must authorise this declarant.

Logging in

To do so start IDEP and log in with the codes contained in the letter from Statistics Netherlands. If you are logging in for the first time, you will see this screen. Here you can check but you not change your company data.

Fill in the e-mail address under company information. If you change your password, you will receive confirmation at this e-mail address. Confirmation of receipt of declarations will also be sent to this e-mail address. Tick the flow or flows for which you are declaring. For each flow you then need only to fill in the fields 'Contact person', 'Telephone no.' and 'E-mail address' if they differ from those under company information.

Contact person

It is important that you add your own name as contact person for the PSI. Statistics Netherlands will continue to send all correspondence about reporting requirements to you - the PSI - not to the third-party declarant. For this reason, please fill in your name, email address and telephone number here. The email address will be used for notifications, and new passwords.

Commodity flow

Indicate the commodity flow for which you are required to provide the statistical information. Tick the flow or flows as specified in the letter you received from Statistics Netherlands. For each flow it is possible to fill in names of other contact persons, but in this case leave them empty. This is not yet the screen through which you can grant the authorisation. Go to [Save and back](#).

Adding a third-party declarant

From the start screen, go to the menu [Declarant](#) and select [Authorise third-party declarant](#).

Then select [Add third-party declarant](#) to add the third-party declarant.

VAT number (BTW-nummer)

Enter the VAT number (or *BTW-nummer*) of the third-party declarant, without the letters NL. Then go to [Check](#)

If the VAT number (or *BTW-nummer*) is already known at Statistics Netherlands, the name will appear automatically and you can add it directly.

If the VAT number (or *BTW-nummer*) is not known at Statistics Netherlands, you can complete a web form to have the third-party declarant added by Statistics Netherlands. You can call up the *web form* via the hyperlink in the yellow text block.

Which commodity flows?

Tick the commodity flow or flows for which you want to authorise the third-party declarant. Fill in the name, email address and telephone number of the contact person.

Letter to third-party declarant

The third-party declarant will receive a letter from Statistics Netherlands, informing him/her that he/she has been authorised by your company to make declarations on your behalf. This letter will contain the log-in codes for the third-party declarant.

If your situation changes

You must enter any changes in your situation in IDEP yourself. The name of the contact person, corresponding telephone number and email address can be changed at any time. If you receive a letter from Statistics Netherlands indicating a change in your reporting requirements, you must enter this as well. From the menu go to **Declarant** **Your company information and reporting requirements**. Then to **Declarant** **Authorize third-party declarant** to change the reporting requirements there too.

As the PSI, you must always check the authorisation yourself and adjust it if necessary. You may also withdraw the authorisation at all times.
