Registered unemployment down

Registered unemployment fell again in the period March-May 1999, according to figures just released by Statistics Netherlands. The average of 227 thousand for this period is just over sixty thousand lower than in the same period last year, the equivalent of an average drop of five thousand a month.

Unemployment rates continue to fall

The 227 thousand unemployed for the period March-May is nineteen thousand down on the period February-April. As a fall of fifteen thousand is usual for this time of year, after seasonal adjustment the new figure is still four thousand lower than in February-April.

Decrease of five thousand a month

The unemployment figures are based on a sample survey and are therefore subject to a certain margin of error. The figures are best seen in a long-term context. Compared with one year ago, unemployment in March-May was 62 thousand lower, which is the equivalent of an average fall of five thousand a month.
