Consumption up by 2.8% in April

The volume of domestic consumption by individuals in April was up 2.8% on April a year ago. The increase not as high as in previous months according to the latest figures by Statistics Netherlands. On average the monthly increase in January through April was 3.9%. In 1998 and 1999 the growth rate likewise stayed around 4%.

Modest increase in food expenditure

Expenditure on food, beverages and tobacco increased by 0.5% in April. The increase is entirely in beverages and tobacco. There was a slight drop in expenditure on food.

Fewer durable goods bought

The growth rate in the expenditure on durable goods fell somewhat. The volume of expenditure on durables was up 2.0% on April last year. There was a substantial drop in the number of new cars bought. Despite the fact that the growth rate was lower in April, expenditure on durables were substantially higher in the first 4 months of the year 2000 than in the same period of 1999. The increase came to 6.0% for this period.

Expenditure on other goods up by 3.2%

Services growing consistently

The volume of expenditure on other goods increased by 3.2% in April. This consumption category consists of energy, fuel and non-durable goods such as flowers, plants, magazines, newspapers, medicines, make up and cleaning products.

Expenditure on services is the largest consumption category. Services are growing consistently. The volume in April was up 3.4% than in April 1999. The growth rate for the first four months stands at 3.6%. This figure is about the same as the annual growth rate during the past three years.
