Employment: great differences between Utrecht and the northern provinces

The positive developments on the job market in 1999 made that unemployment continued to fall in all provinces. At the national level unemployment was cut by half in the period 1994-1999. In the northern provinces, however, unemployment was not reduced by as much as this. Unemployment also fell in the big cities according to the latest figures by Statistics Netherlands published in the Labour Force Survey of 1999.

All provinces benefit from the positive employment situation

The positive developments on the job market in 1999 made that unemployment continued to fall in all provinces. Between 1994 and 1999 unemployment was halved in the Netherlands. The unemployment figure fell from 8.5 to 4.1% of the labour force. However, unemployment was not cut by as much in the northern provinces. In the province Groningen unemployment fell from 11% in 1994 to 7.5% in 1999. This is not anywhere near a 50% drop. This makes unemployment in the north still the highest in the country.

Job market best in Utrecht

Prospects on the job market were best in the province of Utrecht in1999. Utrecht traditionally has the highest labour force participation rate and the lowest unemployment figure. Only 3.0% of the labour force was unemployed in the province of Utrecht, which is substantially below the national average of 4.1%. The participation rate was 66% for the province of Utrecht, while the average for the Netherlands as a whole was 64. North Brabant and Gelderland also had unemployment rates below the national average, as has been the case for years.

Unemployment in Amsterdam and Rotterdam remains high

In Amsterdam and Rotterdam the employment situation has been unfavourable for years. Unemployment did fall in these two cities as well in 1999 but it was still substantially higher than the national average. Amsterdam had an unemployment figure of 6.8% and Rotterdam had 6.6%. In The Hague and Utrecht city the employment situation improved in the nineties. In 1990 unemployment was about as high as in Amsterdam and Rotterdam. Now unemployment in the The Hague and Utrecht city is barely above the national average.
