New record import and export levels

In October the value of the export of goods was much higher than in October 1999. Imports and exports have never been higher. The latest trade figures by Statistics Netherlands show that imports increased by 24% on October 1999 to a total amount of 43 billion guilders (19 billion euro). Exports were up 21% than a year ago, totalling 45 billion guilders (21 billion euro). The increases were in the same vain as the average for the first nine months of this year. The fast growing Dutch trade is mainly due to price increases. Trade with countries outside the EU increased faster in October than trade within the EU. This was also the case in previous months.

The trade balance for the first 10 months of 2000 was positive, worth 25 billion guilders or 11 billion euro.

Trade with the EU

In October 2000 the Netherlands imported 23 billion guilders or 10 billion euro worth from EU countries, up 13% on October 1999. In the first nine months of 2000 Imports from EU-countries likewise increased by 13% on the corresponding months in 1999.

Exports to the EU-countries were up 18% on October last year, and amounted to 34 billion guilders (16 billion euro). In the first nine months of 2000 exports rose by 20% on the corresponding months in 1999. The trade balance with the EU-member states was positive in the first 10 months of 2000, worth 105 billion guilders (48 billion euro). Substantial increase in trade with non-EU-countries

Statistics Netherlands is a department of the Ministry of Economic Affairs In October 2000 the Netherlands imported 20 billion guilders (9 billion euro) worth of goods from countries outside the EU, up 39% on October 1999. In the first nine months of 2000 imports increased by 30%. Fastest percentage growth in imports was with Australia.

Exports to non-EU countries were up 31% on October last year, and worth 11 billion guilders or 5 billion euro. In the first nine months of 2000 exports here increased by 26%. Exports to Asia grew particularly fast. The trade balance with countries outside the EU was negative, worth 80 billion guilders or 37 billion euro.
