Increase in the number of motor vehicles in 2000

On 1 January 2001 there were over 7.9 million motor vehicles registered in the Netherlands including 6.5 million cars. The total number of motor vehicles increased by almost 4% on the year before, according to the latest figures by Statistics Netherlands. The number of cars increased by 3%, not as much as in the previous year. The number of motor bikes went up by almost 6% to a total of 438 thousand.

Almost one car for every two inhabitants

Nearly 1 out of 2 residents of the Netherlands owns a car. However, there are great differences between the various age categories. Only 1 in 15 people aged 18 and 19 owns a car; in the age class 20 to 25 this is 1 in 4. Well over half of all inhabitants aged between 30 and 60 own a car whereas it is slightly over 1 in 3 for people over 65.

Increased number of motor bikes

On 1 January 2001 there were 438 thousand motor bikes in the Netherlands, up nearly 6% on the year before.

There are striking differences between the age groups, as is the case with cars. Less that 1% of people between 18 and 25 own a motor bike, whereas in the age group between 30 and 50 some 6% of the inhabitants owns a motor bike.

Statistics Netherlands is a department of the Ministry of Economic Affairs Some 11% of all cars is registered as a company car, according to Statistics Netherlands. These are mainly cars owned by lease companies. Such cars are of significantly more recent vintage than privately owned cars. Almost a third is of the company cars is less than a year old. This is barely 6% for privately owned cars. About 1% of the motor bikes is owned by a company. However, this share seems to be on the increase, since 7% of all motor bikes sold in 2000 is registered in the name of a company.
