Oil puts downward pressure on Dutch manufacturing prices

The price level of Dutch manufactured goods in June was down 0.7% on May. According to the latest figures by Statistics Netherlands this is mainly caused by falling oil prices. When the oil prices are not taken into consideration, the prices of Dutch manufactured goods are at the same level as in May. In June domestic selling prices fell by 0.3%, and export prices by 0.8%.

Compared to June last year the prices of Dutch manufactured goods are up by an average of 3.6%.

Price rises slowing down

In the long-term perspective taken by Statistics Netherlands, the prices of Dutch manufactured goods are no longer rising as fast. In the year 2000 prices were on average 11.4% higher than in 1999. By the end of 2000 there was a slowdown in the price rises of Dutch manufactured goods. From January through June 2001 prices were only 5.6% higher than in the same period last year. The price rises of imported and exported goods fell faster than the prices for domestically sold and consumed industrial products.

Price drop in the oil industry

In June, the prices for oil products fell by 5.0% on May under the influence of trends in the world market. Petrol prices fell substantially during this period. Compared to June a year ago the price level of the oil industry is 3.3% higher this June.

When the developments of the oil prices is not taken into consideration, the price level of Dutch manufactured goods in June was not 0.7% lower than a month ago, but at the same level. The year-on-year effect of the oil prices has virtually ceased to exist.

Both rising and falling prices

The lower price levels in June compared to May are mainly caused by lower prices in the oil industry. Statistics Netherlands also observed price drops in other branches in June. The prices of products produced by the food industry, paper and cardboard and the chemical industry

Statistics Netherlands is a department of the Ministry of Economic Affairs fell. Price rises were observed in the leather and leather goods industry and in machinery and equipment.

Industrial consumption prices down

The prices of raw materials and semi-manufactured goods consumed by Dutch industry in June fell by 1.2% on May this year The figures by Statistics Netherlands show that this is mainly due to lower prices of Dutch produced raw materials and semi-manufactured goods (-2.7%). Agricultural prices fell substantially (-9.6%). Imported raw materials and semi-manufactured goods went up slightly in price (+0.1%). Compared to a year ago the average industrial consumption prices in June were up by 3.1%.

Producer prices month on month percentage changes


