Industrial turnover virtually constant

Dutch industrial turnover in the period July – August 2001 was hardly greater than it was in July – August of last year. Domestic sales fell by 1%, while the export of Dutch manufactured goods increased by 2%. On balance turnover as a whole increased by 1% according to the latest preliminary figures by Statistics Netherlands.

Small but positive influence of selling prices and extra working day

Selling prices rose by almost 1% on July – August last year, moreover July – August 2001 had one more working day. Preliminary calculations put their positive influence on more than 1%.

Food industry growing fastest

The largest turnover increase in July - August 2001 was in the food, beverages and tobacco industry. The turnover increase matched the rising prices. Sales went up by 6% on July – August last year. In the Netherlands turnover in the food branch went up by 5%, and in the export markets by 7%.

Biggest dip in oil industry

The largest dip in turnover was observed in the oil, chemical and rubber industries. Sales on the domestic market fell by no less than 13%. Sales abroad showed a small 1% turnover increase. On balance the total turnover in this branch fell by 4%. Especially the sales of oil were heavily under pressure within this branch, mainly because selling prices fell by almost 8%.
