# Number of welfare and unemployment benefits no longer falling

The number of welfare and unemployment benefits fell in the second half of the year 2001, according to the latest figures by Statistics Netherlands. The number of welfare benefits fell to a total of 323 thousand at the end of September 2001, while the number of unemployment benefits fell to 166 thousand. There was a substantial slowdown in the rate at which these numbers were falling.

The number of labour disablement benefits, on the other hand, was still increasing, although the rate of increase in 2001 was not as high as in 2000.

#### Over 300 thousand welfare benefits

The number of welfare benefits at the end of the third quarter of 2001 was 323 thousand, which is 18 thousand less than the year before. This drop was substantially less than the 29 thousand in the previous twelve months.

# Fewer couples on welfare

The largest drop in the number of welfare recipients was found among married and unmarried couples, namely 8%. There was only a 3% drop among single parents. Since the benefits for couples are mainly registered in the man's name, and since single parents are mostly women, the number of men on welfare decreased by more than the number of women. The difference between men and women among single persons without children is much smaller.

# Drop in unemployment benefits levelling off

On 31 December 2001 the number of unemployment benefits paid was166 thousand, down 23 thousand on the year before. Between December 1999 and December 2000 the decrease was 34 thousand. The decrease among men was slightly larger than among women: in 2001 there were 13 thousand fewer men on unemployment benefits and 10 thousand fewer women.

### Smaller increase in labour disablement benefits

The number of labour disablement benefits increased by 24 thousand to a total of 981 thousand at the end of the year 2001. The increase is smaller than the increase of 31 thousand in 2000. The labour disablement benefits increased mainly on account of women over 35. The number of men on labour disablement has almost stayed the same over the last year. The number of women on labour disablement increased by 23 thousand.
