Unemployment rising sharply

Dutch unemployment increased to an average of 377 thousand during the first quarter of 2003, according to the latest figures by Statistics Netherlands. The unemployed labour force grew by 95 thousand persons on the same period last year. Unemployment increased from 3.8 to 5.1 percent of the labour force within one year. Employment stopped growing.

Unemployment rising across the board

In the months of January - March 2003 the number of unemployed people averaged 377 thousand. The seasonally corrected unemployment figure was 367 thousand. Compared to last month, the seasonally unemployment figure increased by 29 thousand.

At first, rising unemployment mainly involved men. Now unemployment is also increasing among women. The unemployment percentage among men increased from 3.0 percent last year to 4.6 percent. Among women unemployment rose from 5.0 to 5.7 percent. Compared to last year, unemployment increased in all age categories and both sexes.

Growth in employment has come to a halt

In the period January - March 2003 the number of people employed in a job of twelve hours a week or more was 7 064 thousand. This is about the same number as last year. Until recently employment continued to increase, albeit slower than before. However, in recent months the employed labour force started to decrease.


